**Main Purpose of Job:** Provide quality care for patients attending DDRC Healthcare. Provide hyperbaric skills (as developed) and clinical care for patients in and outside the chamber(s). To act in accordance with NMC standards, and ensure that registration and indemnity cover are valid. Contribute to research and development as required by Line Manager.

**Responsible to:** Clinical Nurse Manager

**Responsible for:** The assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of holistic care for patients at DDRC. To undertake an active role in developing team working methods, assisting in the development and maintenance of staff training and education.

Supporting non-clinical staff with training and supervision for hyperbaric therapy.

Supervision and mentorship of Student Nurses, and other Paramedical visitors at DDRC in agreement with the Clinical Nurse Manager and after appropriate training. Maintaining own NMC registration and adherence to Code of Professional Conduct.

**Key Working Relationships:** Patients, Doctors, DDRC Nursing staff, Chamber and Administration staff, allied Primary and Secondary care Health Professionals

### Main Tasks:

General nursing duties within the Centre.

Maintenance of clinical stock levels and ordering.

Auditing care and undertaking evidence based wound care.

Working with the Clinical and Chamber Teams in planning patient care, and working autonomously using appropriate guidance.

Hyperbaric chamber and mono-place chamber attendant training.

Undertaking pre-assessment telephone contact and scheduling patient care with Administration and clinical staff to ensure seamless patient treatment.

The assessment of patients prior to Hyperbaric Treatment.  
Undertaking Hospital Liaison visits to In-Patients in the Plymouth area in line with staffing constraints with the Hyperbaric Medical Centre.  
Safe management and administration of drugs in line with DDRC Healthcare policy and maintenance of stock levels.  
Teaching on internal and external courses related to hyperbaric medicine and associated care.  
Liaison with allied professionals to ensure that patient needs are met with current best practice interventions.  
Undertaking CPD / reasonable step to ensure that nursing skills are up to date.

**Key Challenges of the Job:**

Increase knowledge base and expand clinical skills to ensure that DDRC Healthcare remains a centre of excellence.  
Advance knowledge in hyperbaric therapy, diving health and associated subjects.  
Development of nursing guidelines and patient care pathways in line with hyperbaric service development.
